



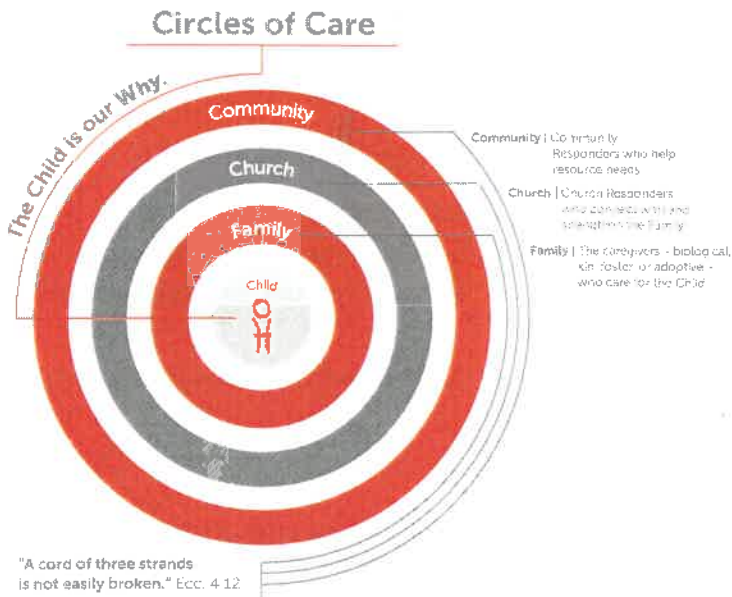

A child welfare professional identifies a need of a local child or family — like a crib for a new mom in California or a mentor for a youth transitioning out of foster care in North Carolina.

They submit a request into CarePortal's platform, which quickly sends a message to participating churches nearby.

Each church can respond directly back to the caseworker when they are able to meet the need, or they can engage other churches and community partners who want to help.

Whether one church responds — or a whole community of churches, businesses, and caring people work together — a local church is always at the point of care for the child or family in need.

Every request presents the opportunity for churches to make meaningful connections. Sometimes that connection involves meeting one need at just the right time. At other times, it develops into a lasting relationship.

	Prevention	Foster Care	Adoption	Transition
TIER 1 Physical	Provide resources to stabilize the environment of children and their caregivers.			
TIER 2 Relational	Support children and families through time and relationship.			
TIER 3 Family	Open your home to children or families, temporarily or permanently.
