May she cry out to her Creator for help in times of trouble. May she find rest and renewal in Jesus.
- Overwhelming stress has infiltrated the hearts of the whole neighborhood. Pray for fathers that
  have short fuses. May they come to hear and genuinely believe that "gentle words are a tree of
  life." May they turn from the ways of this world with life-altering "never-going-back"
  repentance.

But as it approaches, we're feeling depleted and we're not sure if we'll have enough energy— a few weeks later Thanksgiving gathering is going to be huge. (Homeschool is not an option with our immigration status.)

## Ethnos360/New Tribes Mission PNG, Papua New Guinea – Summer Zimmer

- Pray for wisdom for me in purchasing commercial flights to attend the Eastern Area Conference that I'm meant to be able to attend at the end of March. Because of the fuel shortages, our mission planes are no longer able to take me and many others.

- There are many support staffing shortages. Pray for the Lord's provision of people willing to serve Him here, short term or long term.

- We have a busy March and April, but we are excited for all the events happening. We are learning when to say "no" and how to plan when the need is great. We would love prayers for this so we can make sure our team isn't burning out and having the support they need.
- Pray for Kenya as it is very dry and that rain would come this dry season.
- Pray for the leadership in Kenya. Leaders are changing a lot of things that are impacting Kenyans
  in a negative way, resulting in higher taxes, inflation and lack of jobs. We are hopeful that they
  will provide some relief to their people.
- Pray for our clients as we have recently had an increase in children who have been sexually
  abused, and it is difficult to know this is happening more in the community. We are thankful
  they are getting support and that we can be there to support them and their family.

- We are so excited to be in Kenya and be with our team! It is very hot, but we are loving the summer weather and mango season!
- Over the past few months, we have been wanting to find an apartment for our family close to the office since staying on its property. Praise the Lord our office is busy, and it is time for us to move out. Thankfully, God helped us secure a place that is only a 13-minute walk from the office. This will be so great to have when we are in Kenya!
- God has been so good to us! We have had a great start of the year both in the States and in Kenya! In January, Jason and I were back in the States for fundraising and now in Kenya. We have been able to expand our team, grow our programs and provide multiple events already! We have already hosted three Healing Groups, Support Groups and currently have a three-day Trauma Competent Caregiver Training.
- We launched our Young Adult Day Center this month and have had a great response. One day
  we had 35 young adults and have been able to get them connected to counseling, support with
  finding a job, sharing the Gospel and mentoring them. We are so excited to see how God will
  use this program to support our Young Adults.

## **LeaderSource Teams in the Nations – Jim Brenneman Prayers for Jim:**

- Jim helps to write Bible-training materials for frontline leaders in the nations. Our Theology Project is now in use in China by hundreds of leaders and it is also in use throughout Africa and in our ministry to Muslim-Background-Believers. Pray for these writings on practical theology.
- One of our current projects is a very elementary presentation of basic Bible truth for new believers in a program for building disciples, especially for China. Pray for Jim's work of writing.
- He still builds leaders around the world via the Web, including frequent interactions to answer questions about the Bible, Christian doctrines and ethics. He is even teaching Hebrew.
- Jim also provides notes for a year-long plan to read through the whole Bible chronologically. Pray for the hundreds of people involved in this daily Bible reading.
- Mentoring ministry connects him with young men in America, as Jim shares a spare bedroom in his home with college students. Connection with the previous house-guest continues (Francisco from Costa Rica and Cesar from Venezuela. Pray for both of these young men.

- Pray for our increasing reach into the Muslim world including Sudan, Syria, Yemen, Saudi Arabia, Iran, Iraq, Afghanistan, Pakistan, launching from Egypt – especially also in connection with the conflict in Gaza and other neighbors of Israel.
