Muslim World

- Pray for our increasing reach into the Muslim world including Sudan, Syria, Yemen, Saudi Arabia, Iran, Iraq, Afghanistan, Pakistan, launching from Egypt.
- The most recent areas of outreach include North Africa in Liberia, Morocco, and Algeria. Pray in particular for Ousamma in Morocco and for the couple in Algeria Nasser and Dihia.
- Pray for the team in Egypt as they work with orthodox and evangelicals, as well as Muslim Background Believers. Our Egypt team is serving as a very effective Family of God Church in Cairo especially as they demonstrate the love of God to empty and hurting Muslims.

China – Major Gathering

 the level of security risk. But to our surprise God suddenly provided a private location. Now,
 after rigorous planning and logistical work, we feel at peace that it can be done well. So we are
 doing it.
- This will be MW's first trip (or any LS people the West) to China after almost 5 years!
- We are really praying that this will become a very strategic, even historical time for the church in China, a major milestone toward the fulfilling of God's purposes for His church! Not because we are so big, but because of God's love for China! Thank you for joining us in this big hope and prayer. It's all about Him and for Him!

Sub-Saharan Africa

- Pray for the recent launch of four separate INTENSIVE full-time training programs for building emerging leaders in West Africa. These programs are being led by young men and women of God who are themselves being mentored and nurtured by mature believers.

 these nations in the VALUES Africa program; Chris, who handles many details, will be

 to aid Dickens in transportation, including serving the South Sudanese Refugees. In the past, I
 (Beth) used MAF Mission Aviation Flights, but this greatly limits carrying supplies to the
 Refugees. A pickup truck allows more than one person to travel along.

- Lastly, as part of the above transition, I (Beth) am seeking God's direction regarding a visit with Ugandan Royalty to promote their support of the Christian VALUES program/curriculum. I (Beth) am also praying with an expatriate, Stephanie, about taking BSF (Bible Study Fellowship) into the Women's prisons in Jinja, Ethiopia.
- Please pray for Ethiopia as they are reaching out to new regions, and even into Somalia, a very difficult and complicated place to go.
- Please continue to pray for God's provision for printing the Swahili translation of the Self-Control Module. Please pray for the Scripture Union Tanzania (SUTz) worker, Rodrick, who has spearheaded VOICE Training throughout Tanzania. Please pray for word to get out about Hope Academy and for more children to enroll in the morning program before October 15th when enrollment closes.
