What Should I Expect?

Upon arrival, enjoy hot chocolate and coffee. Photo booths will be available in the Main Lobby and on the Lower Level for picture-taking. The family-friendly service will feature a children's story, Christmas worship, a message of hope, the lighting of the Christ candle, and a candlelight vigil.

Do I Need to Arrive Early?

Seating is general admission. To ensure the best experience, we recommend arriving 15 minutes before the service starts. If you're checking in children ages Birth-3 yrs., consider arriving 20 minutes early.

I'm New - Where Do I Go Upon Arrival?

We want you to feel at home when you come to WCC. One of our Welcome Team Members will be honored to assist you upon your arrival. Enter through the Main Upper Level doors and head to the New Here Kiosk at the Info Center in the Lobby where one of them can assist you.
