Job Summary

This role is responsible for leading and directing all worship and praise segments during worship services. Leads a team of volunteers for music and performing arts and technical support. Leads weekly worship arts rehearsals.

Job Classification

Full Time/Exempt. This Salaried position will typically-require at least 40 hours per week. Workdays are generally Sunday through Thursday, with some evening responsibilities.

Essential Functions

1. Sunday Service Programming & Planning & Execution (30%)

- Collaborate with Worship Arts Team in the weekly selection of songs for Sunday Worship
- Attend and contribute to the Sunday Service Cross Team Collaboration Meetings
- Oversee and Implement Creative Worship Elements (prayer, scripture, verbal transitions, creative elements, etc.)
- Lead weekly rehearsal session
- Lead Sunday morning worship service (2x per month)

2. NexGen Worship Ministry (25%)

- Support Associate Pastor with planning NexGen strategy and services
- Build and maintain NexGen Worship volunteer pipeline
- Shepherd and care for NexGen Worship Arts Volunteers
- Support NexGen Events (Camp With An Impact, JAM Camp, etc.)

3. Special Services, Volunteers & Other Responsibilities (45%)

- Support volunteer recruitment, such as auditions, and other recruiting activities
- Shepherd and care for (Non-NexGen) Worship and Technical Arts volunteers, as assigned
- Contribute to and participate in the technical training of Worship Arts Volunteers
- Program, plan, and execute Nights of Worship and staff time worship
- Contribute to and participate in the worship performances for Special Services (e.g., Christmas Eve, Easter, etc.)

- Contribute to and participate in the management, replacement and servicing of Band Equipment (drums, keyboards, guitars, etc.)
- Provide back-up support for management and service of Technical Equipment (A/V, stage, light, sound, etc.)
- Participate in WCC staff meetings and other teams, as assigned
- Participate in general pastoral duties at Warsaw Community Church, which include baptism, weddings, funerals, and Pastor On-Call
- Lift up to 25 lbs
