

# Christmas Eve Services FAQ

## What should I expect?

When you arrive, you can enjoy complimentary hot chocolate and coffee. There will be a photo booth available in the main lobby for you to take pictures with family and friends. Each of our three Christmas Eve Services is one hour long, family-friendly, and includes Christmas worship, a message of hope, the lighting of the Christ candle, and a candlelight vigil.

## Do I need to arrive early?

Seating is general admission. For the best experience, we recommend arriving about 15 minutes before the service begins. If you are checking in children ages birth through 3 years old, you may want to arrive about 20 minutes early.

## I'm new to WCC. Where do I go after I arrive?

We want you to feel at home when you come to WCC. One of our Welcome Team members would be honored to assist you when you arrive. Enter through the main upper-level doors and head to the **New Here** kiosk at the Info Center in the lobby, where a team member can assist you.

## What should I wear?

Come as you are and wear whatever you are comfortable in. Some people will dress up for Christmas, while others will wear a T-shirt and jeans.

## Is there something for my kids?

Sonlight Children's Ministry is available for children ages birth through 3 years old during the 2:30 and 4:00 p.m. services. Our **Sensory Room** is also open during those service times for children who may benefit from a quieter, smaller environment.
